The church survey we conducted this spring revealed that the majority of responders wanted to see our church grow, particularly the children & youth programs, but improvement was needed.

We held a meeting last week about childhood education for the fall and we are definitely looking at making some changes. We're looking at moving classes to Wednesdays, either right after school (3:15) or right after supper (6:00 - supper will be served at church from 5-6 and hopefully we have cooks for each week – another opportunity to serve! (3); and a possible 1-room multi-age class on Sundays after church.

To make this next year's Christian Ed the best possible for our children, we need your help. We will need around 6 adults or older youth to volunteer as teachers & helpers, but we want to

know what time would be best for our volunteers – Wed. afternoon, Wed. evening, or Sunday
morning – and based on your responses, program planning will proceed for the time slot when
we have an adequate number of leaders. It is a commitment of a few hours a week, but it can
make a big impact on a kid's life to have you share the Gospel and some of yourself with them.

what time or times work for you.
